

Guildhall Walk Healthcare Centre: Services are changing

From 1 July, 2016 there will be some important changes to the way Guildhall Walk Healthcare Centre operates.



From that date, walk-in appointments will only be available for people who are registered at Guildhall Walk Healthcare Centre for their ongoing care. Anyone who is not registered at the Guildhall Walk GP practice, but who wants urgent help or treatment for a minor illness or injury, should instead consider the following options:

Your GP surgery: they will offer a 'same day' service if you need help urgently.

Your local pharmacy: they can give advice and treatment for a wide range of minor health problems, without an appointment.

The NHS 111 phone service: open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

St Mary's Treatment Centre: from 1 July this service will offer walk-in appointments with GPs or nurses – whichever you need to see – if you have a minor illness or injury which needs urgent attention. St Mary's is on Milton Road, Portsmouth PO3 6DW. The bus routes passing near St Mary's are 2, 17, 19, and 21.



Guildhall Walk: you can register as a patient at Guildhall Walk Healthcare Centre for your ongoing care, instead of being registered with your current GP.

Opening hours

From 1 July, 2016 the opening hours at Guildhall Walk Healthcare Centre are:

- **8am - 8pm** on Mondays and Fridays
- **8am - 6.30pm** on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays
- **8am - noon** on Saturdays and Sundays
