RECORD OF CHAIR'S ACTION

Background and Summary:

As reference by the Policy and Guidance manual '24-hour retirement is a process by which members of the NHS pension scheme seek to qualify for their retirement benefits whilst continuing to work (albeit with a break).

24-hour retirement usually involves resigning from all involvement in an NHS contract, not returning to the NHS in any capacity for at least 24 hours and not working for more than 16 hours a week in the first month of retirement. The Commissioner should ensure that it is aware of the current conditions around 24-hour retirement'.

The Primary Care Commissioning Committee is asked to consider the changes of a GP Partner who has taken a 24 hour retirement. This change will require a Contract Variation for the removal and re-joining of Dr Richard Mannings of the Personal Medical Services Contract for Portsdown Group Practice.

Dr Richard Mannings – 24 hour retirement on 30th April 2020 returning on 1st May 2020

Total number of GP Partners 12
WTE GP Partner 10
WTE Salaried GP 5.2
Total number of GPs 23
Total WTE Clinical staff excluding GP's/Partners 29.2

RAW total of patients at practice as of March 2020 - 43877

Total average patients per GP = 1908
This equates to 4388 patients per WTE GP Partner
This equates to 2887 patients per WTE GP
This equates to 988 patients Per WTE GP and WTE additional workforce

Dr Mannings will be providing 16 hours per week for the first month of his return, following which he will revert to full time hours. This complies with the regulations.
